



2018 - 2019 FBANC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

All current law students in good academic standing and those admitted to law school for the 2018-2019 academic year are encouraged to apply for the Foundation of the Filipino Bar Association of Northern California (FBANC Foundation) Scholarships. This year, the FBANC Foundation will present four scholarships: (a) Two (2) FBANC Foundation Scholarships in the amount of \$5,000; (b) the FBANC Nassiri & Jung Foundation Public Interest Scholarship in the amount of \$3,000; and (c) the Raymond L. Ocampo, Jr. Family Scholarship in the amount of \$10,000.

The scholarships will be awarded at FBANC's 38th Annual Installation Dinner on June 8, 2018 at the Intercontinental Mark Hopkins Hotel located at 999 California Street, San Francisco, CA.¹ **All scholarship recipients must attend the Dinner.**

A COMPLETE SUBMITTED APPLICATION PACKET MUST INCLUDE:

1. **CONTACT INFORMATION SHEET** (attached herein).
2. **BIOGRAPHY AND PHOTOGRAPH** (biography should be no longer than 2 paragraphs. If selected, the submitted biography and photograph will be featured in the program for the annual. FBANC reserves the right to edit any biography as necessary.)
3. **CURRENT LAW SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT or ADMIT LETTER FROM LAW SCHOOL.**
4. **RESUME** (no more than one page).
5. **COVER LETTER** (no more than one page).
 - a. Discuss your FBANC involvement and list any FBANC events (include the year) that you have attended.
 - b. Discuss why you are applying for an FBANC scholarship and discuss your achievements.
6. **SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY:** Scholarship essays must be double-spaced, no smaller than 12-point type in Times New Roman or similar font and may not be longer than two (2) pages.

Please respond to the following:

How do you currently or how do you plan to uplift and/or defend your community as a legal advocate? Community can be defined as you see fit (i.e, Filipino community, legal community, law student community, family, neighborhood)

Candidates will be judged on their ability to address the question presented thoughtfully and concisely, their persuasiveness, their academic standing, their demonstrated interest in issues affecting the Filipino/Filipino-American community, and their desire to serve the Filipino/Filipino-American community. The FBANC Foundation Scholarship Committee may conduct interviews of finalists as necessary.

Application packets must be received on or before **Wednesday, May 9, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.** Please direct all inquiries and completed applications by email to Scholarship Committee at mentorship@fbanc.org.

In addition to the application packet, the Scholarship Committee may invite applicants to interview with the committee at least two weeks prior to the Annual Dinner.
